the Local Government (Scotland) Acts, order (as follows:-

1. The portion of the said Parish of Port of Menteith above described shall cease to form part of the Parish of Port of Menteith, and shall form part of the Parish of Callander.

2. Nothing herein contained shall affect the rights of creditors or of persons having vested

interests.

3. This Order shall take effect immediately for the purpose of any Order determining the contents and boundaries of electoral divisions under Section 8 (3) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1929, and on the 16th day of May 1930 for all other purposes.
