8	Milton	<p>thence in a north-easterly direction straight to a point on the road from Fintry to Lennoxtown 20 yards north of the northmost point of Geelong Place, thence due south-east till it intersects the road from Benclouch Mains to Lennoxtown, thence direct to the junction of the road between Kilsyth and Lennoxtown with the road between Kirkintilloch and Lennoxtown by way of Kinkell, and thence in a south-westerly direction along the centre of the last-mentioned road to the starting point.</p>
9	Torrance	That part of the parish of Campsie which lies to the east of a line drawn in a southerly direction along the centre of the road leading from Fintry by Lennoxtown and Kinkell to Kirkintilloch, from the point at which the said road enters, to the point at which it leaves, the parish, exclusive of the portion included within the Lennoxtown Division.
10	Kippen	The remainder of the parish of Campsie.

13	Bannockburn	<p>(1) The parish of Logie exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Bridge of Allan, and (2) the parish of Stirling exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the burgh of Stirling and of that portion which lies to the west of the burgh of Stirling.</p> <p>That part of the parish of St. Ninians which is included within the following boundary, viz., a line commencing at a point on the Edinburgh road 250 feet or thereby north-west of the Established Church Manse, thence proceeding in a straight line in a southerly direction to the south-west corner of the lands of Hillpark, thence along the south-western boundary of the said lands and continuing in the same direction till it reaches the River Bannock, thence following the <i>medium flum</i> of the said River in a southerly direction to a point opposite the Sawmill, thence in an easterly direction to the centre of the road leading past Newlands, thence along the centre of the said road in a south-easterly direction past Muiralehouse until it reaches the Pirnhall road, thence along the centre of the said last-mentioned road in a north-easterly direction until it reaches the Edinburgh road, thence in a straight line in a north-easterly direction to a point 400 feet or thereby to the east of Greenyards, thence in a northerly direction until it meets the Cowie road, at a point immediately to the east of the Roman Catholic Chapel and School, thence in a westerly direction along the centre of the last-mentioned road to the point where it crosses the burn near Peters Well thence following the course of the said burn in a northerly direction to the point where it intersects the Station road, thence in a straight line due west until it reaches the River Bannock, thence following the <i>medium flum</i> of the said River in a northerly direction to a point immediately to the north-east of Stirling County Council Sewage Works, thence in a straight line due west to the point of commencement.</p>
14	Cambusbarron	<p>(1) That part of the parish of St. Ninians which lies to the west of the burgh of Stirling and to the west and north of a line drawn in a south-westerly direction along the centre of the road leading from Stirling to Fintry by Coxethill, Murrayshall, Berryhill and Easter Cringate, from the point at which the said road crosses the boundary of the burgh of Stirling to the point at which it enters the parish of Fintry and (2) that part of the parish of Stirling which lies to the west of the burgh of Stirling.</p>
15	Sauchie	That part of the parish of St. Ninians, exclusive of the portion included within the Bannockburn Division, which lies to the south of the Cambusbarron Division and of the burgh of Stirling and to the west of a line drawn first in a south-easterly direction along the centre of the Edinburgh road from the point at which it crosses the boundary of the burgh of Stirling to the point at which it meets the Snabhead road, thence in a south-westerly direction along the centre of the last-mentioned road to the cross-roads at
