SHEEP SCAB MOVEMENT AREAS.

The following Areas are now "Movement Areas" for the purposes of Part II. of the Sheep Scab Order of 1928 :—

1. *Ross and Cromarty.*—An Area comprising the Island of Lewis, including the smaller islands adjacent thereto, in the county of Ross and Cromarty.

2. *Inverness.*—An Area comprising the islands known as the Outer Hebrides (*except the Islands of St. Kilda, Dune, Soay, and Boreray*), in the county of Inverness.
