SHEEP SCAB MOVEMENT AREAS.

The following Areas are "Movement Areas" for the purposes of Part II. of the Sheep Scab Order of 1928 :—

*Inverness*.—An Area comprising the islands known as the Outer Hebrides (except the Islands of *St. Kilda, Dune, Soay, and Boreray*), in the county of Inverness.

*Ross and Cromarty*.—An Area comprising the Island of Lewis, including the smaller islands adjacent thereto, in the county of Ross and Cromarty.
