

be eligible for consideration for appointment to the established staff, subject to the occurrence of vacancies. Appointment to the established staff is conditional on the issue of a certificate of qualification by the Civil Service Commissioners; in the event of the Commissioners declining to issue a certificate of qualification, the candidate will not be retained in the Service.

11. A fee of 8s., being the balance of the prescribed fee of 16s., is payable to the Civil Service Commissioners before the certificate of qualification can be issued.

RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport after the expiry of at least forty days from this date, in pursuance of the power conferred upon him by the Road Traffic Act, 1930, to make Regulations relating to the propulsion of motor vehicles by the use of compressed gas.
