

SCHEDULE.

Save as provided in the Order, no person shall drive or cause to be driven any heavy or light locomotive, motor tractor, heavy motor car, or any motor car with seats for more than seven persons exclusive of the driver, on High Street, Dunblane.

Provided that nothing in the Order shall prevent the driving upon the said road of any vehicle which is being used:—

(i.) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any house, building or other premises situate on or adjacent to the said road.

(ii.) in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said road, or the laying, alteration or repair in or near to the said road of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, post or supports.
