LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACTS.

ORDER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

WHEREAS the contents and boundaries of the electoral divisions of the County of Angus (in this Order called "the County"), the number of County Councillors for the County, and the number of Councillors to be elected by the Town Councils of the Burghs entitled to be represented on the County Council were determined by an Order dated the 26th September 1929 made by the Secretary of State under Section 8 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1929:

AND WHEREAS on the representations of the Town Councils of the small burghs in the County and of the County Council of the County I am of opinion that it is expedient to alter the number of County Councillors for the County and the assignment of County Councillors to the Burghs and to alter the contents and boundaries of the electoral divisions of Liff and Benzie (No. 9), Mains and Strathmartine (No. 10), and Carmyllie and Arbirlot (No. 29) to the extent and in the manner hereinafter provided:

NOW THEREFORE I, the undersigned, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in virtue of the powers conferred on me by Section 51 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1889, as read with the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1929, do hereby order as follows :—
