

(1) The number of County Councillors for the County shall be increased from 68 to 70.

(2) The Order of the Secretary of State dated the 26th September 1929 so far as relating to the electoral divisions of Liff and Benvie (No. 9), Mains and Strathmartine (No. 10), and Carmyllie and Arbirlot (No. 29) is hereby recalled, and from and after the date hereof the area comprised in the said electoral divisions so far as it now forms part of the landward area of the County shall be divided into electoral divisions having the following descriptions and contents:—
