NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

Notice is hereby given under section 168 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Minister of Health, acting jointly, after the expiration of at least twenty-one days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred by paragraph (m) of Part II. of the First Schedule to that Act, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make a special order to be entitled the National Health Insurance (Subsidiary Employments) Order (No. 2), 1937.
