MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1926.  
IMPORTED MARGARINE.

A Draft of an Order in Council under the Merchandise Marks Act, 1926, to require imported margarine to be marked with an indication of origin has been laid before Parliament as required by Section 7 of the Act.

The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that in pursuance of the powers conferred on Them by the Public Works Loans Act, 1897 (60 and 61 Vict. c. 51), the Public Works Loans Act, 1917 (7 and 8

Geo. 5, c. 32), the Public Works Loans Act, 1918 (8 and 9 Geo. 5, c. 27), the Housing Act, 1936 (26 Geo. 5 and 1 Edw. 8, c. 51), and the Housing (Scotland) Act, 1925 (15 Geo. 5, c. 15), as amended by the Housing (Scotland) Act, 1935 (25 and 26 Geo. 5, c. 41), They have been pleased to direct by Their Minute of the 9th May 1939 that on loans granted from the Local Loans Fund, on and after the 10th May 1939, there shall be chargeable in lieu of the rates fixed by the Treasury Minute of the 31st March 1939 the following rates of interest:—
