## AIR NAVIGATION ACTS, 1920 AND 1936.

Notice is hereby given that, after the expiration of 40 days from the date hereof, it is proposed to submit to His Majesty in Council, under the provisions of the above-mentioned Acts, the Draft of an Order in Council entitled "The Air Navigation (Amendment) Order, 1946."

And Notice is hereby further given that, in accordance with the provisions of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, copies of the proposed Draft Order in Council can be obtained by any Public Body within 40 days from the date of this Notice, at the Privy Council Office, Whitehall.

WHEREAS the Secretary of State has, in the exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Education (Scotland) (Superannuation) Acts, 1919 to 1939, as read with section 1 of the Reorganisation of Offices (Scotland), Act, 1939, framed a Scheme amending the Superannuation Scheme for Teachers in Scotland approved by His late Majesty King George the Fifth in Council on the 19th day of March 1926 (S.R. & O., 1926 (No. 363, page 449)):

And whereas the said amending Scheme has been laid before each House of Parliament in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts and neither House has presented an Address praying His Majesty to withhold His assent from the said amending Scheme, or any part thereof:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, having taken the said amending Scheme (a copy whereof is hereunto annexed) into consideration, is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to approve the same and to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the said amending Scheme shall take effect as from the 2nd day of July 1945.

AMENDMENT (1945) OF THE SUPERANNUATION SCHEME FOR TEACHERS (SCOTLAND), 1926, DATED SEPTEMBER 24, 1945, FRAMED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE EDUCATION (SCOTLAND) (SUPERANNUATION) ACT, 1919 (9 & 10 GEO. 5, c. 17), AS READ WITH SECTION 1 OF THE REORGANISATION OF OFFICES (SCOTLAND) ACT, 1939 (2 & 3 GEO. 6, c. 20), AND UNDER SECTION 52 OF THE EDUCATION (SCOTLAND) ACT, 1945 (8 & 9 GEO. 6, c. 37).

Whereas the Scottish Education Department, in the exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 3 of the Education (Scotland) (Superannuation) Act, 1925 (15 & 16 GEO. 5, c. 55), framed an amending Scheme (the Superannuation Scheme for Teachers (Scotland), 1926, hereinafter referred to as "the Scheme"), which received approval by Order in Council dated the nineteenth day of March 1926 and came into operation on the first day of April 1926 (S.R. & O., 1926 (No. 363), p. 449):

And whereas in pursuance of sub-section 2 of section 8 of the Education (Scotland) (Superannuation Act, 1919

(9 & 10 Geo. 5, c. 17), as applied by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Education (Scotland) (Superannuation) Act, 1925, and sub-section (2) of section 4 of the Teachers (Superannuation) Act, 1937 (1 Edw. 8 & 1 Geo. 6, c. 47), the Scheme has been amended by subsequent Schemes (S.R. & O., 1928 (No. 1044), p. 493; 1929 (No. 1179), p. 432; 1932 (No. 1073), p. 471; 1933 (No. 1169), p. 800; 1936 (No. 715) I., p. 909; 1937 (No. 1157), p. 704; and 1942 (No. 1056) I., p. 172):

And whereas the said Scheme is deemed to have been further amended by section 52 of, and the First Schedule to, the Education (Scotland) Act, 1945 (8 & 9 Geo. 6, c. 37):

And whereas it is expedient that the Scheme be amended further:

And whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the Reorganisation of Offices (Scotland) Act, 1939, the functions (including the powers and duties) of the said Department have been transferred to and vested in one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in virtue of the powers vested in him by section 8 of the said Act of 1919 and all other powers in that behalf, hereby frames the following amending Scheme.

1. Article 1 of the Scheme shall be amended as follows:—
  - (a) A new paragraph (2) shall be inserted as follows:—
    - (2) The 'Secretary of State' shall mean one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State; provided that in relation to a function exercised before the fourth day of September 1939 the said words shall be construed as a reference to the Department."
  - (b) In paragraph (4)—
    - (i.) for the words "Education (Scotland) (Superannuation) Acts, 1919 to 1925" there shall be substituted the words "Education (Scotland) (Superannuation) Acts, 1919 to 1939, and the Education (Scotland) Act, 1945";
    - (ii.) after the words "section 2 of the Teachers (Superannuation) Act, 1925" there shall be added the words "and section 1 of the Teachers (Superannuation) Act, 1945";
    - (iii.) for the words "Teachers (Superannuation) Acts, 1918 to 1925" there shall be substituted the words "Teachers (Superannuation) Acts, 1918 to 1945".
  - (c) In sub-paragraph (iii.) of paragraph (6) for the words "schools approved by the Department for the purposes of the Children and Young Persons (Scotland) Act, 1932" there shall be substituted the words "approved schools within the meaning of the Children and Young Persons (Scotland) Act, 1937".
  - (d) To clause (i.) of sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (7) there shall be added—
 

" , after the 1st day of July 1945 in a school conducted by an education authority, or in respect of which grants are paid by the Secretary of State to the managers of the school other than grants in aid of the managers' contributions under the Education (Scotland) (Superannuation) Acts, 1919 to 1939, or "
  - (e) For clause (iii.) of sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (7) there shall be substituted the following clause:—
    - (iii.) In an approved school within the meaning of the Children and Young Persons (Scotland) Act, 1937, or "
