## A PROCLAMATION

REVOKING A PROCLAMATION, DATED THE 31ST DAY OF MAY, 1955, DECLARING THE EXISTENCE OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE EMERGENCY POWERS ACT, 1920.

Whereas by virtue of Our Proclamation, dated the Thirty-first day of May, nineteen-hundred and fifty-five, We did declare the existence of a state of emergency for the purposes of the Emergency Powers Act, 1920:

And Whereas it appears to Us that the state of emergency has now ceased to exist, and that it is expedient that the said Proclamation should be revoked accordingly:

Now, therefore, We, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, do hereby proclaim, direct and ordain that the said Proclamation of the Thirty-first day of May, nineteen-hundred and fifty-five, is revoked.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace, this twenty-first day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine-hundred and fifty-five, and in the Fourth year of Our Reign.
