##### CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956

##### THE EDINBURGH (SIGHTHILL NO. 1) SMOKING CONTROL AREA ORDER, 1958

NOTICE is hereby given that Edinburgh Corporation in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 1st day of May 1958 made an Order entitled the Edinburgh (Sighthill No. 1) Smoking Control Area Order, 1958, defining the area described in the schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for Scrutiny for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area, the occupier of that building shall, for guilty of an offence, and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels are—anthracite and semi-anthracite, branmeated fuels carbonised in the processes of manufacture, coke, electricity, gas, low temperature combustion fuels, and low volatile steam coals.

3. Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the office of the Town Clerk, City Chambers, High Street, Edinburgh, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the nineteenth day of May, 1958.

4. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Department of Health for Scotland, St. Andrews' House, Edinburgh, 1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
