Her Majesty's Postmaster General hereby further gives notice in accordance with paragraph (3) of Regulation 25 of the Telephone Regulations, 1961 that until further notice the charges applicable to the Services and facilities mentioned in the headings of columns 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of the Schedule hereto provided in relation to telephone calls from the United Kingdon or the Isle of Man to Belgium, Germany, Netherlands and Switzerland shall be those set out in the said Schedule,

- 1. This is a booking charge in respect of an application for a call to a specified name and address for the specified purpose of communication with any telephone number at that address (not being a call of the kind mentioned in column 3 or 5).

This charge is not payable where a booking charge for a personal call has been paid.
- 6. Except as otherwise stated in the schedule, the charges specified therein are payable in addition to any other charge payable by virtue of the Telephone Regulations, 1961 for or in respect of the call or the application therefor.
