

**THE EDINBURGH CORPORATION (MERCHISTON AVENUE) (TRAFFIC) ORDER, 1964**

ON 3rd December 1964, Edinburgh Corporation made an Order under Section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is that:

1. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle in Merchiston Avenue between Granville Terrace and the south side of Merchiston Mews otherwise than in a south to north direction.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle proceeding:
  - (i) Westwards in Dorset Place southwards into Merchiston Avenue or Merchiston Mews.
  - (ii) Northwards in the southern portion of Merchiston Avenue into Dorset Place.
  - (iii) Westwards in Merchiston Mews into Dorset Place.
