STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAYS IN THE CITY OF EDINBURGH

THE Secretary of State for Scotland hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 46 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act, 1947, as read with the Transfer of Functions (Roads, Bridges and Ferries) Order, 1955, authorising the stopping up of a length of George Square and the improvement of lengths of George Square and George Square Lane, Edinburgh. The title of the Order is the Stopping Up of Highways (City of Edinburgh) (George Square No. 3) Order, 1967.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question its validity, or any of the provisions, on the ground that it is not within the powers of Part III of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act, 1947, or that any other requirement of Schedule 6 of that Act has not been complied with may within 6 weeks from 2nd June 1967, apply to the Court of Session for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any of the provisions.
