SCHEDULE

The effect of the Order will be that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait on that part of Well Road, Auchinleck (Unclassified) which extends from its junction with Main Street (Trunk Road A.76) to its junction with School Road; but nothing in the Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait as often and for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from such vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from a vehicle, or to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose on any other road, to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the improvement or maintenance of the road or the services therein.
