1. * is added in those instances where the whole three words are used as the "ordinary name" or in the signature as they legally may be; but it is open to the Heads of any of the Houses concerned to add the designation as part of the name and by doing so regularly make those three words their "ordinary surname."

2. † indicates that the Arms have been matriculated with chapeau in respect of being a Minor Baron.

3. These names and designations are in Scots law and practice used by:

- The head of the family and his wife.
- The eldest son and his wife, with the adjection "younger," and their eldest son.
- The unmarried daughters, and unmarried daughters of the eldest son.

N.B.—The designations are not used by younger sons.
