List No. 1 of classes of goods the subject of exemption orders by the Restrictive Practices Court under Section 5

THE Registrar of Restrictive Trading Agreements in pursuance of subsection (5) of Section 6 of the Resale Prices Act 1964 hereby publishes the following list of classes of goods in respect of which the Restrictive Practices Court has made an Order directing that they shall be exempted goods for the purposes of the Act.
