WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

RETAIL DRAPERY, OUTFITTING AND FOOTWEAR TRADES WAGES COUNCIL (GREAT BRITAIN)

THE Retail Drapery, Outfitting and Footwear Trades Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity proposals for increasing the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Retail Drapery, Outfitting and Footwear) Order 1967 (Order R.D.O.(50)).

Particulars of the proposals are contained in the Wages Council's Notice R.D.O.(51) which may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below.

The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the above-mentioned proposals if made to it within 14 days from 14th June 1968. Any such representation should bear the writer's address and signature and be sent to the Secretary, Retail Drapery, Outfitting and Footwear Trades Council (Great Britain), Ebury Bridge House, Ebury Bridge Road, London S.W.1. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections, and quote the number of the Wages Council's Notice of proposals R.D.O.(51).

EDINBURGH-STIRLING MOTORWAY The Newbridge to Lathallan Special Road

THE Secretary of State gives notice that he proposes to make the Newbridge to Lathallan Special Road (Side Roads) (Variation) Order 196 to provide for alterations to the Newbridge-Kirkliston road (B.800) and the Breast Mill-Newbridge Road when this section of the Edinburgh-Stirling motorway is constructed
