## PRIVY COUNCIL OFFICE

### ANCIENT MONUMENTS CONSOLIDATION AND AMENDMENT ACT 1913

NOTICE is hereby given that Her Majesty in Council was pleased on the 31st July 1969 to approve an Order in Council under the above-named Act applying section 14 of the said Act (which provides for penalties for injury or defacement) to certain monuments specified in the Order. The Order also provides that section 14 of the Act shall no longer apply to certain other specified monuments.

THE Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity hereby gives notice that on 17th September 1969 she made the Offices, Shops and Railway Premises Act 1963 (Exemption No. 8) Order 1969. The Order exempts, until 31st December 1970, switchrooms in Post Office manually operated public telephone exchanges from the requirements relating to overcrowding imposed by Section 5(2) of the Offices, Shops and Railway Premises Act 1963. The Order is made in consequence of the transfer by the Post Office Act 1969 to the Post Office (established under the Act) of certain functions of the Postmaster General. The Order replaces the exemption currently given by the Offices, Shops and Railway Premises Act 1963 (Exemption No. 5) Order 1968, which it revokes.

## PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966

Report by the National Board for Prices and Incomes

*An agreement relating to the salaries of certain staff employed by British Insulated Callender's Cables Limited and certain other companies.*

ON 27th June 1969, in pursuance of her powers under section 2(1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity referred to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for their examination and report the agreement made on 14th April 1969 between British Insulated Callender's Cables Limited and the Staff Association representing graded staff comprising Foremen, Clerical and Technical Staff on salary ranges up to a maximum of £2,000 per annum, employed by British Insulated Callender's Cables Limited, British Insulated Callender's Construction Com-

pany Limited, British Insulated Callender's Cables—Burndy Limited, British Copper Refiners Limited and W. T. Glover and Co. Limited providing, amongst other things, for an increase of six per cent effective from 1st July 1969 in the individual salaries of all graded staff employed by the said companies. The Board has now made its report entitled "Pay of Staff in British Insulated Callender's Cables Ltd.". In accordance with section 5(1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity hereby gives notice that the report was first published as Command Paper Number 4168 on 24th September 1969.

## EDUCATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 1962

THE Secretary of State hereby gives notice that, in pursuance of the powers conferred on him by section 125 of the Education (Scotland) Act 1962 he has confirmed the scheme entitled

for the future government and management of the endowments administered under the Highlands and Islands Educational Trust Scheme 1936.

Unless within one month from the date hereof a petition in terms of subsection (8) of the said section is presented to the Court of Session or to the Secretary of State, Her Majesty's approval of the scheme may be signified by an Order in Council without the scheme being laid before Parliament.

## THE FRASERBURGH (TRUNK ROADS) (RESTRICTION ON WAITING) ORDER 1969

THE Secretary of State proposes to make an order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

This order will impose the following restrictions on lengths of the trunk roads A.92 and A.98 in Fraserburgh:
