## PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966 PAY IN THE WATER SUPPLY INDUSTRY

Direction under Section 5(4) Extending the Period within which the National Board for Prices and Incomes must publish their Report.

WHEREAS the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, the Secretary of State for Scotland, and the Minister of Housing and Local Government, in pursuance of their powers under section 2(1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, referred the abovementioned question to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for examination and have published the text of the reference in the Gazette on 27th January 1970;

And whereas by section 5(3) of the Act, but subject to section 5(4), the Board are required to make their report so as to allow publication within three months of the said date;

Now, therefore, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, the Secretary of State for Scotland, and the Minister of Housing and Local Government, in pursuance of their powers under the said section 5(4), hereby direct that the said period of three months be extended by twelve weeks.
