The County of Stirling (Various Streets, Balfron) (Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 2) Order, 1970

NOTICE is hereby given that the County Council of the County of Stirling made an Order at their Meeting on 23rd April, 1970 in terms of sub-sections (1), (2), (3) and (3c) of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act. 1968 prohibiting vehicles other than public service vehicles from waiting at any time in the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

The Order provides for exceptions to enable a vehicle to wait if it is being used in connection with the loading or unloading of goods, building operations, demolitions, road maintenance, cleansing, postal, firebrigade, ambulance or police purposes.

Road at Balfron in the Parish of Balfron and County of Stirling

Side and section of road on which waiting is prohibited at any time

- 1. Dumgoyne-Kepculloch Road A.875 (known as Buchanan On the East side thereof from its junction with Cotton Street)
  - Street (Unclassified) Southwards to a point two hundred and fifty feet from the said junction.

2. Cotton Street (Unclassified)

On the South side thereof from its junction with Dumgoyne-Kepculloch Road A.875 Eastwards for a distance of two hundred and thirty feet.

## THE BURGH OF STIRLING

(Drip Road, Winchel Place and Lower Bridge Street) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1970

- 1. NOTICE is hereby given that the Provost, Magistrates and Councillors of the Burgh of Stirling have made an Order under Section 1(1), (2), (3) and (3a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 which is to come into effect on 1st June, 1970.
- 2. When this Order comes into effect it will be prohibited to drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 3. Pedestrians will be prohibited at any time on any of the lengths of road or footpaths specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Full details of the Order, together with a map showing the lengths of road and footpath affected may be examined at the Municipal Buildings, Corn Exchange Road, Stirling between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.
- 5. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not winthin the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 20th April, 1970, apply to the Court of Session for the purpose.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Road in the Burgh of Stirling

Length of Road on which driving is prohibited

1. Drip Road

The section thereof extending on the west side thereof from its junction with Back o' Hill Road for a distance of 155 feet in a northerly direction and the east side thereof from its junction with Winchel Place for a distance of 175 feet in a southerly direction.

2. Winchel Place

The section thereof from its junction with Drip Road to its junction with Laurencecroft Road.

3. Lower Bridge Street

The section thereof from a point 340 feet north of its junction with Drip Road for a distance of 180 feet in a northeasterly direction.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Road in the Burgh of Stirling

Length of road or footpath on which pedestrians are prohibited

1. Drip Road

The footpath on the north-east side thereof from its junction with Ramsay Place to its junction with Winchel Place.

2. Winchel Place

The road and footpath thereof from their junction with Drip Road to their junction with Laurencecroft Road.
