FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY: OFFICIAL
CERTIFICATE

THE Secretary of State for Scotland gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food (Scotland) Regulations 1968 he hereby restricts recognition of the Official Certificates reproduced in the Schedule to the Notice published in the *Edinburgh Gazette* dated 18th June 1971 for the importation of meat and meat products from the Federal Republic of Germany, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto. The Live Poultry (Restrictions) Amendment Order 1971
(made 22nd June 1971)

This Order, which came into operation on 24th June 1971, amends the Live Poultry (Restrictions) Order 1971 so as to make Articles 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 applicable to Scotland as well as to England and Wales, and so as to remove the prohibition imposed by that Order upon the movement of poultry into certain specified areas of England and Wales.

County of Ayr Development Plan—County Map

NOTICE Is Hereby Given that on the Second day of July 1971 the Secretary of State amended the above development plan.

A certified copy of the development plan as amended by the Secretary of State has been deposited at the Law Department, County Buildings, Ayr, and another has been deposited at the District Council Office, Kirktonhall, West Kilbride. The amendment allocates substantial areas of land in and near the Hunterston and Portencross areas of the Parish of West Kilbride for the purposes (a) of a general user deep water port with bulk discharging and trans-shipment facilities; (b) of a marine terminal for bulk ore carriers (with an associated stocking area for iron ore and rail terminal); and (c) of industry.

Each copy of the amended development plan so deposited is available for inspection by the public free of charge between the hours of 10 a.m. and 12 noon and between the hours of 2.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on weekdays other than Saturdays.

The amendment of the development plan became operative as from the Ninth day of July 1971 but if any person aggrieved by the amendment desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1947, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the amendment, he may, within six weeks from the Ninth day of July 1971, make an application to the Court of Session.
