Viz.:—The Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 8) Order 1972.

This Order provides that 1, 3-Dichloro-5, 5 dimethylhydantion shall be temporarily exempt from import duty until 1st September 1972, and that the goods listed in the Schedule shall be temporarily exempt from import duty until 2nd October 1972.

The Order comes into operation on 19th July 1972 and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1972 No. 1057.

#### NO RIGHT TURN—ESK BRIDGE INTO ESKSIDE WEST, MUSSELBURGH
