

BY THE QUEEN A PROCLAMATION





And Whereas the present industrial disputes affecting persons employed in the coal mines and in the electricity supply industry do, in our opinion, constitute a state of emergency within the meaning of the said Act of 1920, as so amended.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the said Act of 1920, as so amended, we do, by and with the advice of our Privy Council, hereby declare that a state of emergency exists.

Given at our Court at Buckingham Palace this thirteenth day of November in the year of Our Lord nineteen hundred and seventy-three, and in the twenty-second year of our reign.
