ROYAL BURGH OF ARBROATH

The Royal Burgh of Arbroach (Various Screets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Traffic Regulation) Order 1974

THE Town Council propose to make the above-mentioned Order under Sections I(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968. When this Order comes into effect, vehicles will be prohibited, subject to certain exceptions from (a) Waiting at any time in the lengths of road specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto; (b) Waiting between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of road specified in Part II of said Schedule and (c) Proceeding on the length of road specified in Part III of said Schedule.

Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which, together with relative maps, may be inspected at the Town House, High Street, Arbroath during normal office hours.
