NEW ZEALAND: OFFICIAL CERTIFICATE

THE Secretary of State for Scotland in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food (Scotland) Regulations 1968, as amended by the Imported Food (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1973 hereby restricts recognition of the Official Certificates reproduced in Part I of the Schedule to the Notice published in the *Edinburgh Gazette* dated 12th September 1967 for the importation of meat and meat products from New Zealand, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.
