TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND)
ACT 1972RESTRICTION OF PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT
IN CERTAIN CONSERVATION AREAS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Scotland, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (2) of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning (General Development) (Scotland) Order 1950, has on 14th April 1975 approved the County of Clackmannan (Restriction of Permitted Development) (Alloa Glebe, Clackmannan and Tillicoultry Conservation Areas) Direction 1974.

This Direction requires planning permission to be applied for in respect of development within the curtilage of a dwelling-house; sundry minor operations; development by local authorities; water or hydraulic power undertakings, gas undertakings and electricity undertakings (but excepting from said undertakings any development constructed below ground); where any of these developments are situated within the following Conservation Areas:—Alloa Glebe; Clackmannan; and Tillicoultry.

A copy of the Direction which contains details of the Conservation Areas can be inspected at the office of the County Planning Officer, Marshall House, Alloa, during normal office hours as also can maps of the Conservation Areas.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND)
ACT 1972THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAY
(FREER STREET, EDINBURGH) ORDER 1975

THE Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he has made an order under Section 198 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1972, authorising the stopping up of the entire length of Freer Street in the City of Edinburgh.

The title of the order is The Stopping Up of Highway (Freer Street, Edinburgh) Order 1975.
