(FEES IN THE HIGH COURT OF JUSTICIARY)
(AMENDMENT) 1975

Made 11th November 1975 Coming into operation 8th December 1975

The Lord Justice-General, the Lord Justice-Clerk and the Lords Commissioners of Justiciary, under and by winter of the powers conferred upon them by Section 2 of the Court of Law Fees (Scotland) Act 1895(a) and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, do hereby with the approved of the Treasury enact and declare:—
