

- (iii) At all on-street public parking places in the "Peripheral Area" as described in Part II of Schedule 5 to the said Edinburgh Corporation Order of 1973 the charges will be 10p for 2 hours, 15p for 3 hours and 20p for 4 hours maximum period).
- (iv) The excess charge for leaving a vehicles in any public parking place for longer than the initial period for which payment has been made will be £2.
- (v) The charge payable for a season ticket for the use of a resident's permit in a parking place in the "Central Area" as described in Part I of Schedule 6 to the said Edinburgh Corporation Order of 1973) will be £8 for 3 months, £15.50 for 6 months and £30 for 1 year; and for a season ticket in the "Peripheral Area" (as described in Part II of the said Schedule 6) £4.25 for 3 months, £8 for 6 months and £15 for 1 year. The charge for a daily token in the "Central Area" will be 20p; and in the "Peripheral Area" 10p.

B. Traffic Regulation

- (i) The provisions in the said Order of 1973 prohibiting waiting on main traffic roads will be extended to include the following roads or parts thereof without prejudice to existing controls:—Corstorphine Road, Glasgow Road, Gorgie Road, Mayfield Road, Henderson Terrace and Ardmillan Terrace. Waiting will be prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays. Exemptions and exceptions will provide for essential and public services, traffic emergencies, road works, postal services, boarding or alighting, taxi cabs, vehicles on authorised stances, disabled persons' vehicles, professional calls by medical practitioners and funerals.
- (ii) Waiting will be prohibited at all times in the following roads or parts thereof:—Castle Street, Hill Street, North Charlotte Street, North St. David Street, Rose Street, South Charlotte Street, South St. David Street, Thistle Street, Young Street, Young Street Lane North, Young Street Lane South, Hill Street Lane North and Hill Street Lane South, North West Thistle Street Lane, South East Thistle Street Lane, South West Thistle Street Lane, Rose Street North Lane and Rose Street South Lane. Exemptions and exceptions will provide for essential and public services, traffic emergencies, road works, postal services, boarding or alighting, taxi cabs, vehicles on authorised stances, disabled persons' vehicles, bicycles, professional calls by medical practitioners, funerals and loading and unloading (for not more than 30 minutes).
- (iii) Waiting will be restricted at all times over the whole length of the south-east side of Angle Park Terrace and will be restricted between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays on the north west side of Angle Park Terrace from a point 15 metres or thereby north east of the extended east kerbline of Ardmillan Terrace for a distance of 57 metres or thereby north eastwards. Exemptions and exceptions will provide for essential and public services, traffic emergencies, road works, postal services, boarding or alighting, loading or unloading goods (except between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays), taxi cabs and vehicles on authorised stances, disabled persons' vehicles, furniture removals, funerals and professional calls by medical practitioners.
- (iv) One way traffic will be introduced in the following roads or parts thereof:—
Dean Bank Lane — south to north direction.
Duncan Street — west to east direction.
St. Stephen Street — west to east direction.

C. Addition to Controlled Area

Viewcraig Street, Viewcraig Gardens and Dumbiedykes Road will be included within the Peripheral Area established by the said Order of 1973. On-street parking places for the public and for residents will be made available in these streets. Residential parking places will be restricted to residents holding permits issued by the Council.

D. Adjustments and Alterations within the Controlled Area

There will be numerous minor adjustments and alterations to the Schedules of the said Order of 1973 which describe existing public on-street parking places and residents' parking places.
