WAGES COUNCILS
WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

Reference to the Advisory, Conciliation and Arbitration Service

IN December 1975 the Secretary of State for Employment gave Notice of his intention to make orders abolishing the Retail Bookselling and Stationery Trades Wages Council (Great Britain), Retail Bread and Flour Confectionery Trade Wages Council (England and Wales), Retail Bread and Flour Confectionery Trade Wages Council (Scotland), Retail Drapery, Outfitting and Footwear Trades Wages Council (Great Britain), Retail Food Trades Wages Council (England and Wales), Retail Food Trades Wages Council (Scotland), Retail Furnishing and Allied Trades Wages Council (Great Britain), Retail Newsagency, Tobacco and Confectionery Trades Wages Council (England and Wales), Retail Newsagency, Tobacco and Confectionery Trades Wages Council (Scotland) and establishing the Retail Trades (Food) Wages Council (Great Britain) and the Retail Trades (Non-Food) Wages Council (Great Britain). Objections to the draft orders were received from persons appearing to be affected thereby. The Secretary of State, in pursuance of his powers under paragraph 5(b) of Schedule 1 of the Wages Councils Act 1959, as amended by the Employment Protection Act 1975, referred the draft orders to the Advisory, Conciliation and Arbitration Service for inquiry and report and pursuant to paragraph 6 of the said Schedule, notified the Service of the objections he wished the Service to take into account.

The Advisory, Conciliation and Arbitration Service hereby gives notice pursuant to Section 9(2) of the Wages Councils Act 1959 that it will consider representations on the above reference and these should be made in writing to the office of the Service at Cleland House, Page Street, London SW1P 4ND not later than 10th September 1976.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Scotland has made the following Order concerning the proposed diversion of the London - Edinburgh - Thurso Trunk Road (A.9) at Evanton in the District of Ross and Cromarty.

An Order the effect of which will be that the diversion which he proposes to construct at Evanton will become trunk road on 29th July 1976 and the length of trunk road to be superseded thereby will cease to be a trunk road on 1st April next after the date on which notice is given by the Secretary of State to the Regional Council for the Highland Region that the said diversion is open to through traffic.
