THE TRUNK ROADS (ROUTE A9) (AVIELOCHAN-SLOCHD) (CLEARWAYS) ORDER 197

THE Secretary of State gives notice that he proposes to make an order designating as a clearway that length of the London-Edinburgh-Thurso trunk road (Route A9) in the Highland Region from a point 580 metres or thereby south west of Loch Vaa Railway Bridge in a generally north westerly direction for a distance of 13.8 kms or thereby to point 1150 metres or thereby south east of Slochd Summit Railway Bridge. The order will come into operation on the completion of the trunk road improvements.
