 (APPROVED DISINFECTANTS) (AMENDMENT)
 ORDER 1978
 (MADE 4TH JULY 1978)

This Order which comes into operation on the 25th July revokes and re-enacts with amendments the list of disinfectants approved by the Minister and the Secretaries of State for Scotland and for Wales in Schedule 1 to the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) Order 1978.

The Schedule, as re-enacted, contains lists of approved disinfectants in relation to Orders under the Diseases of Animals Act 1950 dealing with Foot-and-Mouth Disease, Swine Vesicular Disease, Fowl Pest, Tuberculosis and disinfectants approved until further notice in relation to other general Orders made under the Diseases of Animals Act.
