EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations amend the Social Security (Categorisation of Earners) Regulations 1975 by substituting a new provision which disregards for contribution purposes employment as a returning officer or counting officer or of persons appointed by such officers for the purpose of any election or referendum authorised by Act of Parliament.
