DIRECTION PROHIBITING EXERCISE OF POWERS
IN RELATION TO CONTROLLED DRUGS
BIMAL KUMAR GHOSE

NOTICE is hereby given, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971, that the Secretary of State has given the following direction, which took effect on 10th August 1978.

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of sub-section (2) of Section 13 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971, and in Section 14 of that Act, by this Direction, prohibits Dr. BIMAL KUMAR GHOSE, M.B., whose registered address is 101 Herne Hill, London SE24, a doctor within the meaning of that Act, from prescribing, administering and supplying and from authorising the administration and supply of any controlled drug within the meaning of that Act.

This Direction does not extend to the doing of anything in circumstances in which it might lawfully be done without being a doctor.
