## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 1979

The Grampian Regional Council propose to make an Order under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Section 133 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973.

When this Order comes into effect no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any part of Kirk Lane, Macduff.

Exceptions will permit driving for the purpose of:—

- (a) Conveying persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to Kirk Lane;

Where necessary in connection with:—

- (b) the maintenance of the road; and  
(c) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the affected length of road and a Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Roads Department, Woodhill House, Ashgrove Road West, Aberdeen and at the office of the Divisional Road Surveyor, Cape House, Seafield Street, Banff between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m.
