RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS FROM THE

Notice

THE Treasury in pursuance of Section 5 of the National Loans Act 1968 hereby give notice that on or after 17th May 1980.

I. Different rates of interest shall apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);

CANONBIE BYPASS (A7)

THE Secretary of State gives notice that he proposes to make the following two Orders:—

1. The Edinburgh - Carlisle Trunk Road (Canonbie Bypass) (Variation) Order 198, authorising the variation of the route of the southern section of a length of new trunk road to be constructed to bypass Canonbie in the Dumfries and Galloway Region.
2. The Edinburgh - Carlisle Trunk Road (Canonbie Bypass Side Roads) Order 198, authorising the construction, improvement and stopping up of roads due to the construction of the bypass.
