 - ii) The Brechin (Martin's Lane Etc.) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1972; and
 - (iv) The Brechin (Clerk Street/Swan Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1973.
- V. To vary the following Traffic Regulation Orders as shown in the draft Order:—
 - (i) The City and Royal Burgh of Brechin, Regulations as to the use of Parking Places;
 - (ii) The Brechin (Various S:reets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and One-Way) Order 1970;
 - (iii) The Brechin (Prohibition of Waiting Etc. and Parking Places Etc.) Consolidation Order 1972;
 - (iv) The Brechin (Proh-bition of Waiting Etc. and Parking Places Etc.) Consolidation Order 1973.

*Notes:

- 1. The restrictions described at Items II and III of the Schedule will not apply on Sundays.
- Waiting will be permitted for any of the following purposes:—
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle and to load or unload personal luggage;
 - (b) building operations or operations relating to the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the roads or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of sewers or main pipes or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telegraphic line;
 - (c) Police, Fire Brigade, Ambulance and certain other statutory purposes;
 - (d) collection and delivery of postal packets by Post Office vehicles;
 - (e) funerals (if the vehicle is in the service of a funeral undertaking);
 - (f) to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to any of the lengths of road specified at paragraph 9(b)(i) in Part I of the Schedule hereto;
 - (g) licensed taxi-cabs, at appointed stances;
 - (h) delivering goods to or collecting goods from premises adjoining affected lengths of road subject to a maximum waiting period of 30 minutes at any one place;
 - (i) the removal of furniture.
- Provision will be made for the granting of exemptions from the waiting restrictions to severely disabled persons.
