(WAITING AND ACCESS RESTRICTIONS)**

ORDER 1981

1. THE Highland Regional Council have made an Order under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.
2. The Order prohibits waiting of vehicles at any time in Balnacraig Road and Balnacraig Lane and access to the latter will be prohibited.

3. Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:—
 - (a) loading or unloading goods;
 - (b) picking up and setting down passengers;
 - (c) the maintenance of roads; and
 - (d) the supply or maintenance of statutory minimum undertakers' equipment.

In addition access to Balnacraig Lane will be permitted for service vehicles and for vehicles travelling to Muirtown Nursery.
