COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 198

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the above mentioned Acts has prepared a draft Compulsory Purchase Order entitled The Edinburgh-Carlisle Trunk Road (Canonbie Bypass) Compulsory Purchase Order 198, authorising him to purchase compulsorily the land in the Parish of Canonbie in the Dumfries and Galloway Region described in the Schedule hereto for the purposes of constructing a new length of the Edinburgh-Carlisle Trunk Road (A7).

Copies of the draft Order and the map referred to therein have been deposited at the offices of the Scottish Development Department, New St. Andrew's House, Edinburgh and the Dumfries and Galloway Regional Council, Council Offices, Dumfries and at the Post Office, Canonbie and may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 29th July 1981 to 19th August 1981.

Any objections to the Order must be made on or before the 19th August 1981 by a notice in writing addressed to the Secretary, Scottish Development Department, New St. Andrew's House, Edinburgh EH1 3SZ, stating the title of the Order, the grounds of objection and quoting reference R/TCP/DF/62.
