THE ROYAL BURGH OF KIRKCALDY
(TRAFFIC REGULATION)(ST. CLAIR STREET/ROSSLYN STREET) (AMENDMENT)
ORDER 1982

1. THE Fife Regional Council propose to make an Order under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Section 133 of and Schedule 14 to the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973.
2. The effect of the Order will be that the waiting and loading of vehicles will be prohibited and restricted to take account of the new bus laybys, pedestrian refuge islands and length of dual carriageway constructed in St. Clair Street and Rosslyn Street, Kirkcaldy, on the A.92 road. The proposed Order will have the effect of amending and extending the provisions of The Royal Burgh of Kirkcaldy (Traffic Regulations) (St. Clair Street/Rosslyn Street) Order 1973.
3. Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the lengths of the roads which will be affected, a copy of the Order to be amended and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for wishing to make the Order, may be examined at Fife Regional Council Headquarters, Fife House, North Street, Glenrothes, and at Fife Regional Council Area Office, Wemyssfield, Kirkcaldy, during normal office hours in each case.
