ORDER 1982

THE Highland Regional Council have made an Order under Section 1(1), (2) and (3), 28 and 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

This Order provides parking places for taxis in Station Square and New Transport Centre Road and for the disabled in Cameron Square. The Order takes effect on 15th February 1982.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the parking places may be examined at Regional Buildings, Glenurquhart Road, Inverness or the Divisional Roads Office, Lochbridge, Fort William on weekdays from 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. (5.00 p.m. Fridays).

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks from 8th February 1982 apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
