

With effect from 1st April 1982 the method of charging for notices in the *Edinburgh Gazette* will be altered. The word rate will be replaced by set charges for various types of notice. These are as follows:—

A. Notice of appointment of Liquidator	£25.00
B. Notices of Resolutions and Meetings of Members/Creditors	£30.00
C. Notices to Creditors and Annual/Final Meetings of Members/Creditors	£25.00
D. Notice of Application for Winding Up by the Court	£30.00
E. Sequestrations—all notices	£30.00
F. Friendly Societies	£11.50
G. Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Acts—Listed Buildings—Listed Buildings in Conservation Areas—Local Plans—Stopping Up and Conversion of Roads	£35.00 for up to 5 addresses/roads over 5 addresses/roads £70.00
H. Notices outwith the above categories will be charged at a line rate of £19.00 for up to 10 lines of printed matter and an additional £5.00 for each 5 lines or part of 5 lines.	

The charges under A-D are in respect of notices covering one company only. If notices include more than one company, in the same group of companies they will be charged as follows:—

2 to 5 companies	double the single company rate
6 to 10 companies	treble the single company rate

Pre-payment is required for these rates. In the case of notices under H. above pre-payment of £19.00 is required. You will be invoiced for any balance.

The price of the *Edinburgh Gazette* will be increased from 1st April 1982 from 34p to 38p (50p inclusive of postage). Voucher copies will be posted on the day of publication on pre-payment of 50p for each copy required.
