(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1986

- ON the 25th February 1986, The Fife Regional Council made an Order under Section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (2) and 124 of and paragraph 20(1) of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 1st April 1986 will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on certain lengths of Reid Street, Rolland Street and the entrance road to Kirklands, Dunfermline, respectively.
- Exceptions include waiting for the following purposes:-

- boarding or alighting from vehicles;
- the loading or unloading of goods;
