(B9002 AT OYNE VILLAGE)
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1986

THE Grampian Regional Council propose to make the above named Order under Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any person from driving a vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on that length of the B9002 Oyne to Kennethmont Road extending from a point 145 metres east of the Unclassified 238C Oyne Shop Road westwards for a distance of 386 metres.
