PETROLEUM AND SUBMARINE PIPE-LINES ACT 1975

NOTICE OF THE ISSUE OF A SUBMARINE PIPE-LINE WORKS AUTHORISATION

THE Secretary of State for Energy hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to Occidental Petroleum (Caledonia) Limited for the construction and use of a system of chemical injection pipes extending between Claymore 'A' and the Scapa Template.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, each pipe described in column 1 of the Table shown below shall be used only for the conveyance of the things specified in relation to the particular pipe in column 3 of that Table.

SOCIAL SECURITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS FOR REGULATIONS REVISING THE PRESENT SYSTEM OF HELP FOR SUPPLEMENTARY BENEFIT CLAIMANTS DURING PERIODS OF EXCEPTIONALLY SEVERE WEATHER

THE Social Security Advisory Committee gives notice that it has been asked by the Secretary of State for Social Services under Section 10 of the Social Security Act 1980 to consider and report on proposals for regulations revising the present system of help for supplementary benefit claimants during periods of exceptionally severe weather.

A short explanatory note provided by the Department of Health and Social Security on these proposals is appended to this Notice. The Committee will take into account any comments or objections made by or on behalf of people or organisations who would be affected by the proposals received by them not later than 8th September 1986. Comments or objections should be sent to Mrs. U. Brennan, the Secretary, Social Security Advisory Committee, Room 458, New Court, Carey Street, London WC2A 2LS. EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Secretary of State for Social Services proposes to make amendments to the supplementary benefit regulations. The proposed changes will specify the circumstances in which the Secretary of State can announce that a period of exceptionally severe weather has occurred and links local office areas with specific meteorological stations. At the same time the groups eligible for help will be prescribed as will the amount of help available during a period of exceptionally severe weather.
