THE CENTRAL REGION (SHIELDHILL ROAD,
REDDINGMUIRHEAD) (EXTENSION OF SPEED LIMIT)

ORDER 1986

THE Central Regional Council propose to make an Order under Sections 81, 82 and 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which, in effect, will extend the speed limit on the section of Shieldhill Road, Reddingmuirhead as detailed in the Schedule hereto.

Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the proposed restrictions and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at (i) the Regional Council Offices (Room 13), Viewforth, Stirling and (ii) at Falkirk District Council Offices (within the Administration and Legal Department's Enquiry Office) Municipal Buildings, Falkirk for three weeks from 15th August 1986.
