NOTICE is hereby given that Kincardine and Deeside District Council have made a Tree Preservation Order under the provisions of Section 58 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1972, as amended, with respect to woodland as specified in the Order, and shown within a continuous red line on the plan, annexed and signed as relative to the Order situated south of minor road, opposite Harestone Cottages, Crathes, in the parish of Banchory-Ternan, in the county of Kincardine.

The grounds on which the Order has been made are as follows:

- (1) For their contribution to the landscape and form an important landscape feature.
- (2) It forms a small Woodland, the principal species being Oak which is uncommon as a dominant tree in this area.

Certified copies of the Order including the said plan and grounds for making of the Order have been deposited for inspection by members of the public at the Department of Planning and Development, Carlton House, Arduthie Road, Stonehaven, and Kincardine and Deeside District Area Office, High Street, Banchory, between the hours of 9 a.m.-1 p.m. and 2 p.m.-4.30 p.m., Monday to Friday, inclusive.

Objections and representations with respect to the Order must be made to the undersigned in accordance with Regulation 7 of the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order and Trees in Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Regulations 1975, as amended, as follows: 7(1) Every objection or representation to the Planning Authority with respect to an Order shall be made in writing, and shall state the grounds thereof and specify the particular trees, groups of trees or woodlands in respect of which it is made, (2) an objection or representation shall be duly made if it complies with paragraph (1) of this Regulation and is received by the Planning Authority within 28 days from the date of the service of the notice of the making of the Order or
