THE FIFE REGIONAL COUNCIL
(KIRKLANDS, DUNFERMLINE)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1987

1. THE Fife Regional Council propose to make an Order under Sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) and (2) and 124 of and paragraph 20 (1) of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on certain lengths of both sides of Kirklands, Dunfermline.
3. Exceptions include waiting for the following purposes:
 - (a) Boarding or alighting from vehicles
 - (b) The loading or unloading of goods
 - (c) Building or demolition operations
 - (d) Road maintenance, improvement or reconstruction
 - (e) Statutory powers and duties
 - (f) The supply of gas, water, electricity or telecommunications apparatus
 - (g) Bus travel and
 - (h) by disabled drivers
4. Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a plan showing the length of road which will be affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for wishing to make the Order, may be examined without payment of fee at Fife Regional Council Headquarters, Fife House, North Street, Glenrothes, and at Fife Regional Council Area Office, 34 Viewfield Terrace, Dunfermline, during normal office hours.
5. Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should send details of the grounds for objection in writing to the undersigned by 17th April 1987.
